PORTFOLIO 2023 SELECTION OF WORKS Simon Thiou displaces the uses of materials, he gives them another form of life, often cold and almost clinical. Flawless but fundamentally deviant, his cuts, hindrances, outgrowths, grafts, destructions would almost assimilate him to a Doctor Robert Ledgard¹ of sculpture. However, if these unnatural crossings induce dramatic developments that (de)generate forms, giving birth to things that exist right next to us, behind a transparent curtain, the artist first creates fictions. Moreover, by questioning the history of objects as much as their forms and their material, by feeding on science fiction cinema as much as on sculpture, Simon Thiou invents complex and referenced narratives, of which his sculptures would only be the exploded resurgences, the puzzle pieces of a parallel world.


Untitled, 2022 cadastral map on tracing paper, coal, laminated steel $110 \times 18 \times 9 \text{ cm}$

This tool is a standard size 20-22 open-end wrench from a hardware store. The object, made of chrome vanadium, has been artificially oxidized in an electrolysis bath, then restored as faithfully as possible. Presented on a base, in the manner of an ethnographic object, this tool, never having been used, seems to bear the traces of a previous life.

The transformation steps of this wrench were compiled in a video of the same name.


Like the practices of restoring old objects, increasingly popular on YouTube, this video has prompted the creation of a channel on the same site, generating its own space of diffusion.


As for the object, it has become a sculpture and now has its place in the exhibition space.








series **Untitled**, 2021 architecture plans on tracing paper, laminated steel, screws 6 sculptures - 49 x 8,5 x 4 cm each

This selection of works, of the same nature, was realized during the year 2021. Each sculpture is built with an architectural plan on tracing paper, rolled and glued on itself, in A4 or A3 format. These plans were recovered from a discarded stock, from an architect

Each format is the subject of a series composed of elements of the same size. Each element is unique because it is made from an original plan, drawn by hand.

Using the potential of the transparency of the tracing paper, these cylindrical forms are similar to collages. Each tube is assembled to round metallic sections (steel, copper) allowing the paper to be held and hung on the wall.

These forms give to see an abstract graphic composition, whose function remains to be defined.

Parasite, 2020 urban intervention

The project "Parasite" is an urban intervention realized at rue Grécourt in Tours, in October 2020.

At that time, France is lock down and art places are closed. Back from Germany and having no studio, the urban space becomes a place to invest.

The intervention consists in feeding a set of mailboxes of an uninhabited address.

Made in the format of paper advertisements, blank booklets are deposited each week at this address, giving life to a place, like a parallel activity.

The intervention ended after a resident emptied each mailbox mysteriously.









47°23'10.1''N 0°41'24.3''E from the series **Coordinates**, 2020 plaster, bitumen $90 \times 90 \times 10$ cm

The coordinates is an urban molding project that consists in taking plaster prints on road repair sites.

These casts are made after the passage of a planer with spikes, a civil engineering machine that scrapes the upper part of the road, using a drum equipped with tungsten carbide spikes.

These wild imprints constitute an urban archaeology which reveals, in negative, the state of a road, invisible after the end of the building site.

Starting from an urban object, the Kaugummiautomat, in english the chewing-gum dispenser, which has been scattered around the streets of German cities since the post-war period, this video, made in the Eisenbahnstraße in Leipzig, is inspired by the method invented by Jean Rouch and Edgar Morin in the documentary "Chronique d'un été", made in 1961 in Paris.

The color of a chewing gum ball, randomly delivered by a mechanism activated by a 20 cent coin, becomes the pretext for a visual investigation which, through encounters and interviews, mixes different subjects and contexts, creating an aesthetic stroll ruled by coincidence.
























Zone (extended), 2019 - video installation - video projectors, media players, extension cables, plaster - variable dimensions

The installation "Zone" is a video triptych. Each projection shows a space whose nature remains unknown, within which different materials are arranged. The place of the action is a grain tank of a lithographic workshop, the place where images are erased. The point of view transforms this tank into a real architecture, giving the materials that inhabit it a monumental character.



Untitled is a drawing made in smoke black, recalling the ancestral technique of the first drawings. The hexagonal shape of the supports evokes, in a more contemporary way, the mirrors of giant telescopes.





6R-1021.1415926535, 2015 plate tile, tile adhesive, concrete - 205 x 80 x 180 cm




Figures spatiales, 2015 - wood-cement, black smoke (lighter drawing) - 800 x 400 cm, in situ installation







